89th Annual Bucks Co. Fireman's Parade

June 13th, 2009

Rules and Regulations

1. Parade will be held rain or shine and begin promptly at 1:00pm.
2. Registration will be from 9:00am to 12 Noon at Council Rock High School North, 62 Swamp Rd and will be done on a first come first serve basis.
3. All units must report no later than 11:30am to register. Companies not reported by such time will not be eligible for judging.
4. Sirens, bells or air horns **WILL NOT** be tolerated in the line of parade.
5. NO ALCOHOL of any kind will be permitted before and or during the parade. Any Alcohol found on the apparatus will also disqualify the entire company.
6. Designated Drivers must wear assigned wrist bands at all times. Any Driver found not wearing a wrist band will disqualify the entire company.
7. Any intoxicated person will disqualify the entire company
8. Refreshments will be served following the parade. NO one under the age of 21 years of age will be served alcoholic beverages.
9. Beer will be dispensed in official Newtown Fire Association mugs only.
10. All late entries or arrivals will go to the end of the parade.
11. All buses or other transportation units will discharge passengers at assigned locations and proceed to the end of the parade route.
12. Any apparatus not judged prior to the parade will be directed to the assigned judging area following the parade.
13. The use of water for water fights ECT. Is strictly prohibited.
14. No solicitations will be permitted by anyone other than that of the Newtown Fire Association.
15. No combined companies are permitted to march as a single company.
16. Companies are only permitted to have one prize per category.
17. The Newtown Fire Association will not be eligible for any prizes.
18. All units must finish entire parade route to be eligible for awards.

19. ALL JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL.

20. Judging will be done by the Delaware Valley Judges.
21. Any apparatus equipped with an aerial device will be judged in proper aerial category.
22. Any other apparatus falling into several categories will be judged only in the category that is declared at registration.
23. Judges identification cards must be displayed on the passenger side windshield
24. Judging will be done prior to parade and along the entire parade route.
25. Overall appearance of men riding or pulling any apparatus shall be considered in judging appearance.
26. Prizes will be announced as soon as possible after the parade.
27. The Newtown Fire Association, Newtown Boro, and Newtown Township **WILL NOT** be responsible for any damages/ loss to any apparatus or equipment.
